Applications are accepted in April and May. You may place your name on an interest list year-round.

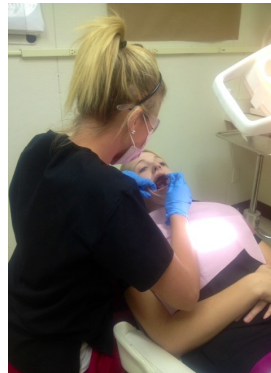
Completion Time:
