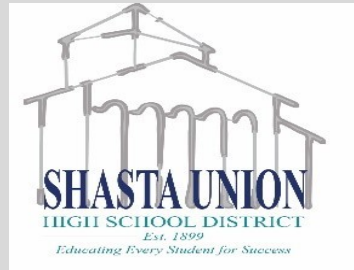

CTE Administration of Justice is designed to give interested students the basic skills and knowledge to understand the complex process of becoming a modern law enforcement officer. The course allows students to study crime causes and cures, the history of law enforcement, criminal arrest and procedures, crime scene investigation and many more areas of the field.

AOJ 2 is offered to students who successfully complete AOJ 1.

AOJ 2 will allow students to participate in an internship program with a local law enforcement agency.

The course progresses to include complete information about modern law enforcement agencies at local, state and federal levels, as well as current information on our court systems.

Included is the teaching of certain hands-on skills used by officers: search and arrest techniques, handcuffing and hand to hand combat.
