Earn Your High School Diploma By Taking The HiSET Equivalency Exam

Why should I take the HiSET Exam? The exam allows you to earn a state-issued, nationally recognized high school equivalency credential which you can use to advance your career, join the military, begin a training program, qualify for financial aid and continue your education. Affordable, accessible and flexible, the HiSET exam is the fastest-growing high school equivalency test.

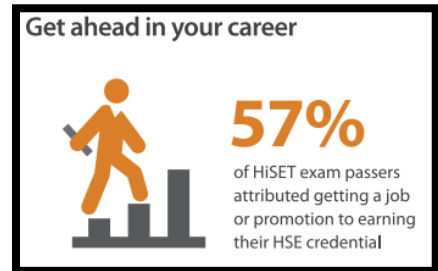
Who is eligible? You must be a resident of the state of California and be at least 18 years old. Students may take the exam on the month they are turning 18, but will not receive results until their birthdate.

What is covered in the exam? This paper-based test includes five subjects: Math, Writing/Language Arts, Science, Social Studies and Reading.

How much does the HiSET exam cost? The total cost is \$125.00, unless using a voucher. You are entitled to 2 free retests for any sections you do not pass (you do not need to re-take subjects that you have passed). Re-takes are valid up to 12 months after your first exam date.

How do I prepare? Free test vouchers are available for students who prep with us and meet our testing criteria. We provide practice tests and individualized appointment-based tutoring leading up to the exam. If you wish to prep on your own, the HiSET website offers practice tests.

When/where is the exam? Shasta Adult School offers the exam at their location: 590 Mary St, Bldg. 60, Redding.

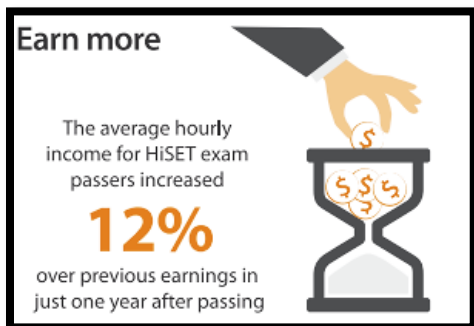

How do I register? Log on to www.HiSET.org. Click on the GET STARTED link on the top of the page. To create an account click on the LEARN MORE ABOUT THE HISET EXAM link. Click on the blue banner that says Sign In/Create an Account link. After you create an account it will assign you a registration number. Please bring this testing number along with \$125.00 by the deadline to our office. Cash, checks or money orders payable to SUHSD are accepted for payment unless using a voucher. You may register Monday-Thursday, between the hours of 9:00 am and 2:00pm.

What happens on test day? Please arrive by 8:15am for check-in. The test process will begin at 8:30 am. Late arrivals will not be admitted. The full five-subject test will last until 4-5pm. No phones or electronic devices are allowed to be used during the test time. Calculators are provided. Please bring snacks and water and a valid ID. We typically take 5-10 minute breaks between tests and one ~20 minute break mid-day.



How do I get my results? Test results are available within approximately 2 weeks of completing the test on the HiSET website.
