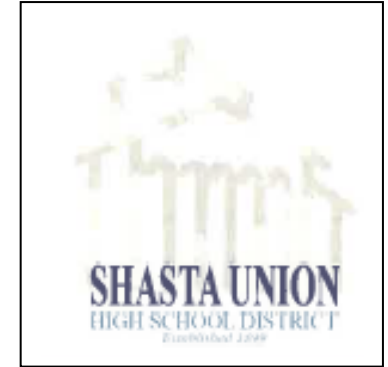

Title VI Indian Education Program Eligibility

Student must be *American Indian* and belong to any of the following:

- Federally recognized Tribe, including Alaska Native
- State Recognized
- Terminated
- Organized Indian Group

To receive services:

A **Federal Form 506** must be completely filled out by the American Indian student's Parent or Guardian and submitted to Indian Education office along with a copy of tribal enrollment. A copy is permanently placed in the school student file.
