# HiSET Test Schedule & Information 2020-2021 School Year

The HiSET test will be given on the dates listed below, starting promptly at 8:30 am. Please arrive by 8:15 am. Late arrivals will not be admitted. The test will be taken at Shasta Adult School, located at 590 Mary St #20, Redding, CA. 96001.

# How much will the test cost?

There are 5 subjects in the test and the total cost is \$125.00, unless using a voucher. Vouchers are available for students who prep with us and meet our testing criteria. You are entitled to 2 free retests.

# Is there help in preparing for the test?

Yes. We offer individual HiSET prep by appointment only. Please call for availability.

#### Eligibility requirements:

You must be a resident of the state of California. You may register Monday-Thursday, between the hours of 9:00 am and 2:00 pm.

#### How do I register?

Log on to <a href="www.HiSET.org">www.HiSET.org</a>. Click on the GET STARTED link on the top of the page. To create an account click on the LEARN MORE ABOUT THE HISET EXAM link. Click on the blue banner that says Sign In/Create an Account link. After you create an account it will assign you a registration number. Please bring your testing number from your HiSET online account along with \$125.00 by the deadline. Checks, cash and money orders are accepted for payment unless using a voucher. Please make checks payable to **SUHSD**.

# How long does the test take?

The test process begins at 8:30am and will last until 4-5pm. Test results are available within approximately 2 weeks of completing the test. No phones or electronic devices are allowed to be used during the test time. Please bring snacks and water and a valid ID. We typically take 5-10 minute breaks between tests and one longer break mid-day.

### Can I cancel my test?

Yes, call our office at least 24 hours before your test date and we can cancel it for you. If you are a no call, no show, it will cost you one of your free retakes.
